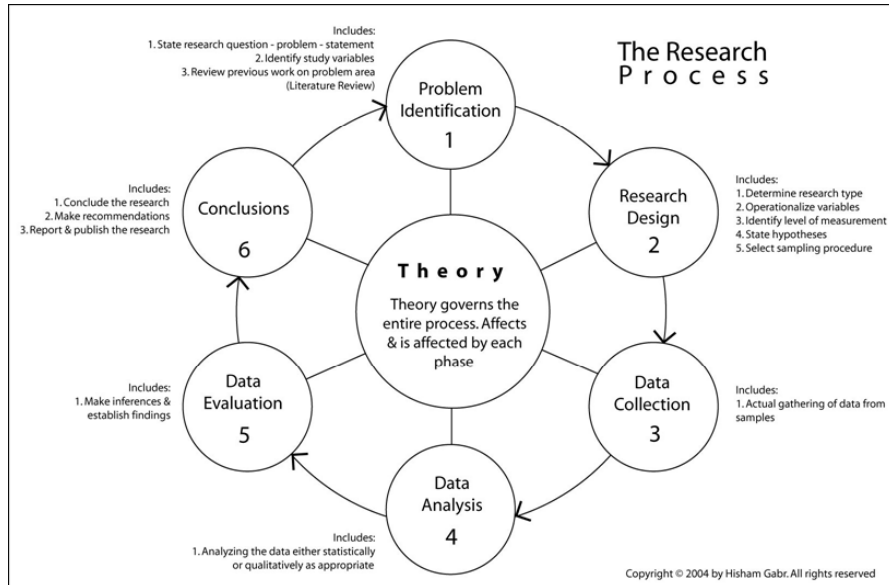

2. Restatement of aims (research)
3. Summarizing the findings (research)
4. Suggesting implications
5. Significance of the findings (research contribution)
6. Limitations of the current study (research)
7. Recommendations for further work (research)
8. Implications/recommendations for practice or policy
